The Team

1 Corinthians 1:10 Words of Unity > AGREEMENT

I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought.

Matt 18:19

“Again, I tell you that if two of you on earth *agree about anything you ask for*, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven.²⁰ For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them.”

- > Pressing past compromise is key towards agreement
- > Compromise results in list keeping, not agreement with a future.
- > Biblical agreement is legally binding that can be as simple as the nod of nod of your head.

Amos 3:3 No Divisions

“Can two walk together unless they agree?”

- > There has to be a purpose, and having “no division” is more than a state of mind. No division implies REMOVING everything in the way.

Ephesians 2:10 Building a Team

¹⁰ For we are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

- > God is the Team Builder and He is the one that builds a team.
- > CREATED: Specific design from God. You are a creation that reflects Christ.
- > WITH A VISION: Hearing the heart of God takes in a marriage takes two to listen to hear His heart.
- > Vision language:
 - Dream together
 - Pray together
 - Seminars together
 - Waiting on the Lord...together.
